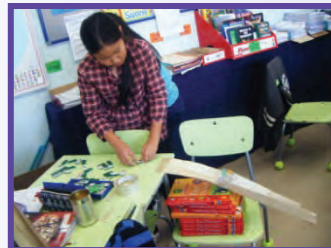
High School Science Fair & Middle School Science Fair
