Pumpkin Math

The First grade students began a pumpkin Math unit this week. The unit focuses on measurement, estimation, comparison, and graphs. We will use the pumpkins to link into Science and observational skills as well. It has definitely been fun to watch the classes get into the Halloween Spirit and enjoy their new pumpkin friends.

The unit began with a ‘get to know your pumpkin’ day. The kids closely observed the physical traits of each pumpkin and estimated which one was the biggest. They identified their pumpkins by weight, size, texture, and appearance. Then they named their pumpkin, and we practiced how to share responsibility in taking care of it. The pumpkins have a home at each group’s table so that the students may observe and explore them during any break time.

On day two, we introduced the children to rulers and measurement and we brainstormed how to measure a curved surface. Then in groups the children practiced measuring, and we made a graph of their information to gauge the accuracy of their estimations.

We will introduce scales and compare the weight of each pumpkin in order to find which is the heaviest and lightest before they are made into happy Jack o Lanterns for our Halloween Spirit Day. In the process of making Halloween crafts, we will de-seed the pumpkins and explore what the insides look like. Some of the seeds will be planted to begin a science observation of growing vines, and we will watch some of the pumpkins decompose to study soil formation.

The pumpkins that are left will make Jack-o-Lanterns and delicious pumpkin bread treats for the classes to enjoy.

Hooray for pumpkins!!! Thanks to all the parents for their support in this Fall season.

Welcome to 5A! Our class is excited to share what we have been doing in October. In Science class we are currently working on Changes in Matter for Science. The students have been learning about insulating devices; how things, like a thermos and ice box, help keep things hot or cold. Their challenge: to make an insulating device that will retain the heat from hot water for 10 minutes. They worked in groups of 2 or 3 and did a wonderful job creating their thermoses. Many of their thermoses managed to stay close to their starting temperature for 10 minutes! In Social Studies we have been studying Ancient Rome. They created posters on Roman Art, Army, Slavery, Forum, Gladiators, and the Circus Maximus and presented their findings in front of the class. We have also been working on Data Management in Math class. To tie this in with our Charlie and the Chocolate Factory novel study in Language Arts, the students participated in a chocolate taste test. The students then created a table and graphs. These can be seen on a bulletin board just outside our room. Come by and take a look! - Ms. Realeza
